Mr. Reilly has spent his career addressing critical environmental issues, serving as President of both the World Wildlife Fund and Conservation Foundation, as Executive Director of the Rockefeller Task Force on Land Use and Urban Growth, and as the first Payne Visiting Professor at Stanford University’s Institute for International Studies. Reilly has served several non-profit organizations in positions which include: Chairman of World Wildlife Fund (WWF), Director of the National Geographic Society, and as a Presidential appointee to the Presidio Trust of San Francisco. Reilly remains on the Boards of Trustees of the American Academy in Rome and The Packard Foundation, and he is chairman of the Board of Advisors of the Nicholas Institute for Environmental Policy Solutions at Duke University.

“Joining Enviance was an easy decision,” said Mr. Reilly. “The Enviance Internet-based workflow platform—the first of its kind—is driving fundamental change in the compliance arena by reducing costs and time, and providing previously unattainable process transparency.
