Dr. Zsebo left Cell Gensys to lead the Biopharmaceutical and Implant Division of ALZA Corporation, and was instrumental in filing the NDA for Viadur®. Subsequently, she was Executive Vice President of Connetics Corporation and prior to joining Enterprise Partners she served as CEO & President of Remedyne Corporation, an early stage biotechnology company based on technology developed from University of California, Santa Barbara.

Dr. Zsebo received a B.S. in Biochemistry from the University of Maryland, a M.S. in Biochemistry from Oregon State University and a PhD in Comparative Biochemistry and Molecular Biology from the University of California, Berkeley. She has published over 100 articles on biotechnology and holds 21 patents in the biotech field.
